standout Most traditional chandeliers have dangly bits that refract whatever light happens to pass through them. But in Kinsley and Staten's Jax fixture, each crystal interacts exclusively with its own LED source, conjuring individual starbursts. The component-based system is sold in 10-, 20-, and 30-light sets that quickly lock together to form a (possibly) never-ending constellation. Satin-anodized aluminum and hand-polished crystal are shaped with a subtle chamfer, a nod to the cut prisms of classic chandeliers.
